
- 1. Secure the tail of the airplane to a stationary object by one of the methods below.
- 2. Insert the release pin and roll the airplane forward to take up any slack.

3. Reel out the line from the recoil handle, set the lock, and place the handle in the cockpit.

4. Set the engine controls and start the engine.

5. Once safely in the cockpit, unlock the recoil handle, pull the release pin and reel in the line.

6. If using the tether, coil it up and return it to the storage bag.
